B.R.I.D.G.E.

1. BELIEVE THE BIBLE

Psalm 119:86a All of your commands can be trusted. (NCV)

James 1:22 Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. **Do what it says**. (NIV)

2. REACH OUT TO OTHERS

Mark 16:15 Jesus said to his followers, "<u>Go everywhere</u> in the world, and tell the Good News to <u>everyone</u>." (NCV)

Galatians 6:2 Stoop down and reach out to those who are oppressed. Share their burdens, and so complete Christ's law. (MSG)

3. INVEST IN PEOPLE

Matthew 20:28 Your <u>attitude</u> must be like my own, for I, the Messiah, did not come to be served, but to <u>serve</u>... (LB)

Philippians 2:4 Forget yourselves long enough to lend a helping hand. (MSG)

Ecclesiastes 11:4 If you wait for <u>perfect conditions</u>, you will never get anything done. (NLT)

Luke 16:13 No servant can serve two masters... You <u>cannot serve both God and money</u>. (NIV)

4. DEVELOP CHRIST-LIKE CHARACTER

Ephesians 4:13b We must become like a <u>mature</u> person, <u>growing</u> until we <u>become</u> <u>like Christ</u> and have his perfection. (NCV)

Mark 14:36 "Father, Father," he said, "everything is possible for you. Take away this cup from me. Yet I want <u>your will, not mine</u>." (LB)

Matthew 4:1 Then Jesus was led by the Spirit <u>into the desert to be tempted</u> by the devil. (NIV)

5. GIVE GOD LOVE

Matthew 22:37-38 Love the Lord your God...' ³⁸This is the <u>first</u> and <u>greatest</u> commandment. (NIV)
