Genesis 24:1-59

The Steps To Success

1. DETERMINE YOUR POSITION

Genesis 24:1 Abraham <u>was now old</u> and <u>well advanced in years</u>, and the <u>Lord had blessed him in every way</u>. (NIV)

2. DEFINE YOUR <u>PURPOSE</u>

Genesis 24:2-4 He said to the chief servant in his household, the one in charge of all that he had, "Put your hand under my thigh. ³ I want you to swear by the LORD, the God of heaven and the God of earth, that you will not get a wife for my son from the daughters of the Canaanites, among whom I am living, ⁴ but will go to my country and my own relatives and get a wife for my son Isaac." (NIV)

Genesis 24:5 The servant asked him, "What if the woman is unwilling to come back with me to this land? Shall I then take your son back to the country you came from?" (NIV)

3. DISCOVER A PROMISE

Genesis 24:7 The LORD, the God of heaven, who brought me out of my father's household and my native land and who spoke to me and **promised me** saying, '<u>To</u> **your offspring I will give this land'--he will send his angel before you** so that you can get a wife for my son there. (NIV)

4. DESIRE IN PRAYER

Genesis 24:12 Then he <u>prayed</u>, "O LORD, God of my master Abraham, give me <u>success</u> today, and show kindness to my master Abraham. (NIV)

5. DIAGNOSE THE PROBLEMS

Genesis 24:58 So they called Rebekah and asked her, "Will you go with this man?" "I will go," she said. (NIV)

6. DESIGN A PLAN

Genesis 24:11-12, 14-15, 22, 32 He had the camels kneel down near the well outside the town; it was toward evening, the time the women go out to draw water. ¹² Then he

prayed, "O LORD, God of my master Abraham, give me success today, and show kindness to my master Abraham.... ¹⁴ May it be that when I say to a girl, 'Please let down your jar that I may have a drink,' and she says, 'Drink, and I'll water your camels too'--<u>let her be the one you have chosen</u> for your servant Isaac. By this I will know that you have shown kindness to my master." ¹⁵ Before he had finished praying, Rebekah came out with her jar on her shoulder... ²² When the camels had finished drinking, the man <u>took out a gold nose ring weighing a beka and two gold bracelets</u> weighing ten shekels... ³² So <u>the man went to the house</u>... (NIV)

7. DISCIPLINE YOUR PERSONALITY

Genesis 24:21 Without saying a word the man watched her closely to learn whether or not the Lord has made his journey successful. (NIV)

Genesis 24:33 When the food was set before him he said, "I will not eat until I have told you what I have to say..." (NIV)

Genesis 24:56 But he said to them, "<u>Do not detain me</u>, now that the Lord has granted success to my journey..." (NIV)

8. DEPEND ON PEOPLE

Genesis 24:54-59 Then he and <u>the men who were with him</u> ate and drank and spent the night there. When they got up the next morning, he said, "Send me on my way to my master." ⁵⁵ But <u>her brother</u> and <u>her mother</u> replied, "Let the girl remain with us ten days or so; then you may go." ⁵⁶ But he said to them, "Do not detain me, now that the LORD has granted success to my journey. Send me on my way so I may go to my master." ⁵⁷ Then they said, "Let's call the girl and ask her about it." ⁵⁸ So they called Rebekah and asked her, "Will you go with this man?" "I will go," she said. ⁵⁹ So they sent their sister Rebekah on her way, along with <u>her nurse</u> and Abraham's servant and <u>his men</u>. (NIV)

9. DEPOSIT THE PRICE

Genesis 24:53 Then the servant brought out gold and silver jewelry and articles of clothing and gave them to Rebecca. He also **gave costly gifts** to her brother and to her mother. (NIV)
