WHY IT'S IMPORTANT TO PLAN

- BECAUSE GOD DOES IT Jeremiah 29:11
- BECAUSE GOD COMMANDS IT Proverbs 16:9
- **BECAUSE GOD BLESSES IT** Prov 16:3

WHAT STEPS TO TAKE

1. THINK IT THROUGH

Nehemiah 2:1 In <u>the month of Nisan</u> in the twentieth year of King Artaxerxes, when wine was brought for him, I took the wine and gave it to the king. I had not been sad in his presence before. (NIV)

Proverbs 13:16 A <u>wise man thinks ahead</u>; a fool doesn't and even brags about it! (LB)

2. TRUST GOD WHEN YOU'RE AFRAID

Nehemiah 2:2-4 so the king asked me, "Why does your face <u>look so sad</u> when you are not ill? This can be nothing but <u>sadness of heart</u>." <u>I was very much afraid</u>, ³ but I said to the king, "May the king live forever! Why should my face not look sad when the city where my fathers are buried lies in ruins, and its gates have been destroyed by fire?" ⁴ The king said to me, "What is it you want?" Then <u>I prayed to the God</u> of heaven. (NIV)

Psalm 56:3 When I am afraid, I will trust in you. (NIV)

3. ESTABLISH A GOAL

Nehemiah 2:5 And I answered the king, "If it pleases the king and if your servant has found favor in his sight, let him send me to the city in Judah where my fathers are buried so that I can rebuild it." (NIV)

1 Corinthians 9:26a So I run straight to the goal with purpose in every step. (LB)

4. SET A DEADLINE

Nehemiah 2:6 Then the king, with the queen sitting beside him, asked me, "How long will your journey take, and when will you get back?" It pleased the king to send me; **so I set a time**. (NIV)

Psalm 90:12 Teach us to <u>realize the brevity of life</u>, so that we may <u>grow in wisdom</u>. (NLT)

5. ANTICIPATE THE PROBLEMS

Nehemiah 2:7 I also said to him, "If it pleases the king, may I have letters to the governors of Trans-Euphrates, so that they will **provide me safe-conduct** until I arrive in Judah?" (NIV)

Proverbs 22:3 A prudent man <u>foresees the difficulties ahead</u> and <u>prepares</u> for them; the simpleton goes blindly on and suffers the consequences. (LB)

6. PREPARE FOR SUCCESS

Nehemiah 2:8 And may I have a letter to Asaph, keeper of the king's forest, so he will give me timber to make beams for the gates of the citadel by the temple and for the city wall and for the residence I will occupy?" And because **the gracious hand of my God** was upon me, the king granted my requests. (NIV)

Proverbs 21:1 The king's heart is like a stream of water in **the hand of the LORD**; he turns it wherever he will. (NRSV)

Proverbs 16:1 We can make our plans, but the final outcome is **in God's hands**. (LB)
