What Can Disconnect And Reconnect Your Relationships

1. YOU CAN BE DISCONNECTED BY FEAR

Three Affects It Has On My Life

When I'm afraid of my FAULTS I become DEFENSIVE

Genesis 3:12-13 The man said, "<u>You gave</u> this woman to me and <u>she gave</u> me fruit from the tree, so I ate it." ¹³...She answered, "<u>The snake tricked me</u>..." (NCV)

When I'm afraid of my FEELINGS I become DISTANT

Genesis 3:10 ... I was afraid because I was naked; so I hid. (NIV)

When I'm afraid of losing my FREEDOM I become DEMANDING

Genesis 3:16 To the woman he said: ..."Your yearning will be for your husband, and <u>he</u> <u>will dominate you</u>." (NJB)

THE KEY TO RECONNECTING: HONESTY

John 14:6 Jesus said: "I am the Way; **the Truth** and the Life. No one can come to the Father except through me." (NJB)

2. YOU CAN BE DISCONNECTED BY PRIDE

Proverbs 13:10a Pride only leads to arguments... (NLT)

THE KEY TO RECONNECTING: HUMILITY

Philippians 2:5-7 Your attitude should be the same that Christ Jesus had. ⁶Though he was God, he did not demand and cling to his rights as God. ⁷He made himself nothing; <u>he took the humble position</u> of a slave and appeared in human form. (NLT)

3. YOU CAN BE DISCONNECTED BY HURT

Proverbs 18:14 The will to live can get you through sickness, but no one can live with a **broken spirit**. (NCV)

THE KEY TO RECONNECTING: FORGIVENESS

Ephesians 4:31-32 Stop being <u>bitter</u> and <u>angry</u> and <u>mad</u> at others. Don't <u>yell</u> at one another or <u>curse</u> each other or ever be <u>rude</u>. ³² Instead, be kind and merciful, and <u>forgive others</u>, just as God forgave you because of Christ. (CEV)

Matthew 6:14-15 If you <u>forgive other people</u> when they sin against you, your heavenly <u>Father will also forgive you</u>. ¹⁵ But if you do <u>not forgive others</u> their sins, your Father will <u>not forgive your sins</u>. (NIV)

Colossians 3:13b Remember, <u>the Lord forgave you</u>, so <u>you must forgive others</u>. (NLT)

1 John 1:9 But if we confess our sins to God, he can always be trusted to **forgive us** and **take our sins away**. (CEV)
