# 1. BE COURAGEOUS AND TAKE THE INITIATIVE

**2 Timothy 1:7** For the Holy Spirit, God's gift, does not want you to be <u>afraid of people</u>, but to be wise and strong, and to <u>love them</u> and <u>enjoy being with them</u>. (LB)

## 2. BE CONSIDERATE OF THEIR NEEDS

1 Corinthians 1:10 I have a serious concern to bring up with you, my friends, using the authority of Jesus, our Master. I'll put it as urgently as I can: You must **get along with each other**. You must **learn** to **be considerate of one another**, **cultivating** a life in common. (MSG)

**Proverbs 17:9** You will keep your friends if you <u>forgive them</u>, but you will lose your friends if you <u>keep talking about what they did wrong</u>. (CEV)

#### 3. BE CONSTRUCTIVE WITH YOUR WORDS

**Ephesians 4:29** Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for **building others up** according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen. (NIV)

Galatians 5:15 If you go on <u>hurting each other</u> and <u>tearing each other apart</u> you will completely **destroy each other**. (ICB)

#### 4. BE CANDID ABOUT PROBLEMS

**Proverbs 24:26** An **honest answer** is a sign of **true friendship**. (TEV)

**Proverbs 27:5-6a** A truly good friend will **openly correct** you. <sup>6</sup>You can trust a friend who **corrects you**... (CEV)

# **5. BE CONFIDENTIAL WITH INFORMATION**

Proverbs 11:13 A gossip tells everything, but a true friend will keep a secret. (CEV)

**Proverbs 16:28** A troublemaker plants seeds of strife; **gossip separates** the best of friends. (NLT)

### 6. BE COMMITTED TO THE RELATIONSHIP

Proverbs 17:17a A friend loves you all the time. (ICB)

**Proverbs 18:24** There are "friends" who pretend to be friends, but there is a friend who **sticks closer than a brother**. (LB)
