### → On His Way To The Cross, Jesus Met...A SKEPTIC.

A SKEPTIC IS SOMEONE WHO HAS "....an attitude of doubt or a disposition to incredulity either in general or toward a particular object." (Merriam-Webster Dictionary)

- → Even Christians Can Sometimes Be **Skeptical**.
- Sometimes we are skeptical of God's PROMISES.

"I tell you, you can pray for anything, and if you believe that you've received it, it will be yours." Mark 11:24 (NLT)

## Sometimes we are skeptical of God's <u>PRESENCE</u>.

"...you can be sure that I am always with you, to the very end." Matthew 28:20b (NIRV)

# Sometimes we are skeptical of God's <u>POWER</u>.

"Don't be afraid, for I am with you.

Don't be discouraged, for I am your God.

I will strengthen you and help you.

I will hold you up with my victorious right hand." Isaiah 41:10 (NLT)

The opposite of <u>skepticism</u> is <u>FAITH</u>.

WHAT CAN WE LEARN FROM ONE WOMAN'S JOURNEY FROM SKEPTICISM TO FAITH?

# 1. We Can Trust Jesus To Accept Us Regardless Of WHO WE ARE.

Soon a Samaritan woman came to draw water, and Jesus said to her, "Please give me a drink." <sup>8</sup>He was alone at the time because his disciples had gone into the village to buy some food. <sup>9</sup>The woman was surprised, for Jews refuse to have anything to do with Samaritans. She said to Jesus, "You are a Jew, and I am a Samaritan woman. Why are you asking me for a drink?" John 4:7-9 (NLT)

### 2. We Can Trust Jesus To Accept Us Regardless Of WHAT WE DO.

<sup>16</sup> "Go and get your husband," Jesus told her.

<sup>17</sup>"I don't have a husband," the woman replied.

Jesus said, "You're right! You don't have a husband—¹8 for you have had five husbands, and you aren't even married to the man you're living with now. You certainly spoke the truth!" John 4:16-18 (NLT)

# 3. We Can Trust Jesus To Accept Us So That We Can ACCEPT OTHERS.

<sup>28</sup>The woman left her water jar beside the well and ran back to the village, telling everyone, <sup>29</sup>"Come and see a man who told me everything I ever did! Could he possibly be the Messiah?" <sup>30</sup>So the people came streaming from the village to see him...<sup>39</sup>Many Samaritans from the village believed in Jesus because the woman had said, "He told me everything I ever did!" John 4:28—30, 39 (NLT)
