HOW TO HANDLE TEMPTATION

1. ANTICIPATE IT

Matthew 26:41 <u>Watch and pray</u> so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the body is weak. (NIV)

1 Corinthians 10:12 So <u>be careful</u>. If you are thinking, "Oh, I would never behave like that"—let this be a warning to you. For you too may fall into sin." (LB)

2. ACCEPT RESPONSIBILITY

James 1:14-15 Temptation is <u>the pull of our own evil thoughts and wishes</u>. ¹⁵ These evil thoughts lead to evil actions and afterwards to the death penalty from God. (LB)

James 1:13 And remember, when you are being tempted, do not say, "God is tempting me." God is never tempted to do wrong, and <u>he never tempts anyone else</u>. (NLT)

3. ASK GOD FOR HELP

Hebrews 4:15-16 Jesus... had the same temptations we do, though he never once gave way to them and sinned. ¹⁶ So let us <u>come boldly to the very throne of God</u> and stay there to receive his mercy and to find grace to help us in our times of need. (LB)

Psalm 50:15 <u>Call to me</u> when trouble comes; I will save you, and you will praise me. (TEV)

4. ADMIT MY STRUGGLE TO A FRIEND

James 5:16 Admit your sins to <u>each other</u>, and pray for <u>each other</u> so that you will be healed. (GW)

1 Corinthians 10:13a But remember this—the <u>wrong desires</u> that come into your life aren't anything new and different. <u>Many others</u> have faced exactly the same problems before you... (LB)

1 Corinthians 15:33 Do not be misled: "<u>Bad company corrupts good character</u>." (NIV)

5. AVOID TEMPTING SITUATIONS

Proverbs 14:16 A wise man is <u>cautious and turns away from evil</u>, But a fool is arrogant and careless. (NASB)

Psalm 119:59 I thought about the wrong direction in which I was headed, and <u>turned</u> around and <u>came running back to you</u>. (LB)

Ephesians 4:27 ... do not give the devil an opportunity. (NASB)

6. AFFIRM GOD'S PROMISES

1 Corinthians 10:13b <u>God is faithful</u>; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, <u>he will also provide a way out</u> so that you can stand up under it. (NIV)

Ephesians 6:17 You must <u>accept salvation from God</u> to be your helmet and <u>receive</u> <u>the Word of God</u> from the Spirit <u>to use as a sword</u>. (JB)

Hebrews 2:18 Because Jesus experienced temptation..., <u>he is able to help</u> others when they are tempted. (GW)
