Isaiah 9:6 A child has been born for us; God has given a Son to us... And his name will be called... **Prince of Peace!** (NCV)

John 14:27 I leave behind with you -- **peace**; I give you My own **peace** and **My gift** is nothing like the peace of the world. Do not be distressed or daunted. (PH)

The Five Keys For Having Peace

1. ACCEPT GOD'S PARDON

Romans 5:1 Therefore since we have been <u>justified through faith</u>, we have <u>peace</u> <u>with God</u> through our Lord Jesus Christ. (NIV)

Isaiah 38:17 My bitterness will turn into peace... You forgive all my sins. (TEV)

2. RECOGNIZE GOD'S PRESENCE

Exodus 33:14 The LORD answered, "My <u>presence</u> will go with you, and I will give you <u>peace</u>." (GW)

Psalm 46:1, 10a God is our refuge and strength, an **ever present** help in trouble. ¹⁰ **Be still and know** that I am God... (NIV)

3. OBEY GOD'S PRINCIPLES

Psalm 119:165-166 Those who <u>love your instructions</u> have <u>great peace</u> and do not stumble. ¹⁶⁶ ...so I have <u>obeyed your commands</u>. (NLT)

Romans 2:10 There will be glory and honor and peace from God for all who obey him... (LB)

4. TRUST GOD'S PLAN

Proverbs 3:5-6 <u>Trust</u> in the Lord with all your heart and <u>lean not</u> on your own understanding. ⁵ In all your ways <u>acknowledge</u> Him and He shall <u>direct</u> your paths. (NKJV)

Isaiah 26:3 You, Lord, give <u>true peace</u> to those who <u>depend on you</u>, because they <u>trust you</u>. (NCV)

5. SURRENDER TO GOD'S PRIORITIES

Matthew 6:31-33 <u>Don't worry</u> and ask yourselves, "Will we have anything to eat? Will we have anything to drink? Will we have any clothes to wear?" ³² <u>Only people who don't know God are always worrying</u> about such things. Your Father in heaven knows that you need all of these. ³³ But more than anything else, <u>put God's work first</u> and **do what he wants**. Then the other things will be yours as well. (CEV)

John 14:1 Jesus said, "Don't let your hearts be <u>troubled</u>. <u>Trust</u> in God. And <u>trust in</u> <u>me</u>." (ICB)

Luke 2:13-14 And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, ¹⁴ Glory to God in the highest, and **on earth peace**, good will toward men. (KJV)
