2 Timothy 4:5a But you, keep your head in all situations... (NIV)

When You Face Compromising Situations:

1. DO THE RIGHT THING

Proverbs 4:26 Be careful what you do, and always do what is right. (NCV)

Proverbs 10:9 People with <u>integrity have a firm footing</u>, but those who follow <u>crooked paths will slip and fall.</u> (NLT)

2. TRUST GOD FOR YOUR FUTURE

Proverbs 23:17 Don't envy evil men but continue to reverence the Lord all the time, for surely you have a **wonderful future** ahead of you. There is hope for you yet! (LB)

Isaiah 49:4b ...I leave it all in the LORD'S hand; **I will trust God** for my reward. (NLT)

When You Face Conflicting Situations:

1. CHANGE YOUR FOCUS

Philippians 2:3-6 <u>Don't be selfish</u>... <u>Be humble</u>... ⁴ Don't think only about your own affairs, but <u>be interested in others</u>, too, and what they are doing. ⁵ Your attitude should be the same that Christ Jesus had. ⁶ Though he was God, he <u>did not demand and cling to his rights</u> as God. (NLT)

2. WATCH YOUR WORDS

Proverbs 18:20 You will have to <u>live with the consequences</u> of everything you say. (TEV)

Ephesians 4:29-32 Don't use foul or abusive language. Let everything you say <u>be good</u> and <u>helpful</u>, so that your words will be an <u>encouragement</u>... ³¹ Get rid of all bitterness, rage, anger, harsh words, and slander... ³² Instead, <u>be kind</u> to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you. (NLT)

When You Face Competing Situations:

1. STOP COMPARING

Galatians 6:4 Let everyone be sure that he is doing his very best, for then he will have the <u>personal satisfaction</u> of work well done and won't need to <u>compare</u> himself with someone else. (LB)

2. REMEMBER GOD'S UNCONDITIONAL LOVE

Romans 5:8 But God showed <u>his great love for us</u> by <u>sending Christ</u> to die for us <u>while we were still sinners</u>. (NLT)

Jeremiah 31:3a ...I have loved you with an everlasting love... (NIV)
