Jeremiah 2:25 <u>Slow down</u>. Take a deep breath. What's the hurry? Why wear yourself out? Just what are you after anyway? But you say, "I can't help it. I'm addicted... I can't quit." (MSG)

Effects of a hurried lifestyle

- I FEEL MORE EXHAUSTED Psa. 6:2
- **I LOSE MY JOY** Job 9:25
- I AM LESS PRODUCTIVE Pro. 21:5
- I CAN'T HEAR GOD Psa. 46:10

Ways to Slow Your Pace

1. LEARN CONTENTMENT

Psalm 131:2 I am **content** and at peace. As a child lies quietly in its mother's arms, so my **heart** is quiet within me. (TEV)

Proverbs 23:4 Do not wear yourself out to get rich; have the wisdom to **show restraint**. (NIV)

1 Peter 2:4 Come to the Lord, the living stone <u>rejected by people</u> as worthless but <u>chosen by God as valuable</u>. (TEV)

2. LISTEN BEFORE SPEAKING

Ecclesiastes 5:2 <u>Do not be quick with your mouth</u>, do not be hasty in your heart to utter anything before God. God is in heaven and you are on earth, so <u>let your words</u> be few. (NIV)

Proverbs 29:20 Do you see a man who **speaks in haste**? There is more hope for a fool than for him. (NIV)

3. OBEY THE FOURTH COMMANDMENT

Exodus 20:9-10a You have six days in which to do your work, ¹⁰ but the seventh day is a day of rest dedicated to Me... (TEV)

Colossians 3:2 Don't shuffle along, eyes to the ground, absorbed with the things

<u>right in front of you</u>. Look up, and be alert to what is going on around Christ—that's where the action is. **See things from his perspective**. (MSG)

4. PAUSE AND PRAY BEFORE DECIDING

Proverbs 19:2 Enthusiasm without knowledge is not good. <u>If you act too quickly, you might make a mistake</u>. (NCV)

Proverbs 20:25 An <u>impulsive vow</u> is a trap; later you'll wish you could get out of it. (MSG)

5. TRUST GOD'S TIMING

Ecclesiastes 3:11 ... <u>God does everything just right and on time</u>, but people can never completely understand what He is doing. (NCV)

Habakkuk 2:3 These things I plan won't happen right away. <u>Slowly</u>, steadily, surely, the time approaches when the vision will be fulfilled. If it seems <u>slow</u>, <u>wait patiently</u>, for it will surely take place. It will not be delayed. (NLT)

Psalm 31:14-15a But I <u>trusted in</u>, <u>relied on</u>, and was <u>confident in</u> You, O Lord; I said, You are my God. ¹⁵ <u>My times are in Your hands</u>... (AMP)
