Seven Passion-Killers

1. AN UNCLEAR <u>PURPOSE</u>

Isaiah 49:4 I have <u>labored to no purpose</u>; I have spent my strength in vain and for nothing. (NIV)

2. AN UNBALANCED <u>SCHEDULE</u>

Psalm 127:2 It is senseless for you to work so hard from early morning until late at night, <u>fearing</u> you will starve to death; for God wants his loved ones to get their proper rest. (LB)

Ecclesiastes 4:4 I have also learned why people work so hard to succeed: it is because <u>they envy the things</u> their neighbors have. (TEV)

3. AN UNRESOLVED CONFLICT

Job 5:2 <u>Resentment</u> destroys the fool, and <u>jealousy</u> kills the simple. (NLT)

Job 18:4a You are only hurting yourself with your anger... (TEV)

4. AN UNSUPPORTED LIFESTYLE

Proverbs 18:24 A man of **too many friends comes to ruin**, But there is **a friend who sticks closer** than a brother. (NASB)

5. AN UNEXAMINED LIFE

Lamentations 3:40 Let us look closely at our ways and examine them and then

return to the LORD. (GW)

2 Corinthians 13:5 <u>Test yourselves</u> to make sure you are solid in the faith. Don't drift along taking everything for granted. <u>Give yourselves regular checkups</u>. (MSG)

6. AN UNDERNOURISHED SOUL

Romans 12:11 Don't burn out; keep yourselves fueled and aflame. (MSG)

Deuteronomy 8:3 ...people do not live by bread alone; rather, we <u>live by every word</u> that comes from the mouth of the LORD. (NLT)

7. AN UNAPPLIED TRUTH

2 Peter 1:5 <u>Make every effort</u> to apply the benefits of these promises to your life. Then your faith will produce a life of moral excellence. A life of moral excellence leads to <u>knowing God better</u>. (NLT)

James 1:22 Remember, it is <u>a message to obey</u>, <u>not just to listen to</u>. So don't fool yourselves. (MSG)
